ORGANIZED PLAY GUIDE

Welcome to the first season of Echoes of Astra: Imperion. This guide will walk you through event scheduling and prizing guidelines. Questions should be directed to contact@parhelion-studio.com

Get your local scene going with this 4-month prizing kit. The prizes are designed for a weekly event schedule with anywhere from 4 to 8 participants. Promotional cards should be used for marketing and getting players for your locals. Please heed the schedule carefully to ensure our own promotional marketing aligns with player expectations!

Prizing Schedule

PARTICIPATION GIFT are meant to be handed out at the end of events for players that sign up and play to the end.

STORE CHAMPIONSHIP

It is an alt art signature foil to commemorate the conclusion of the *Echoes of Astra: Imperion* opening season. There is only **ONE** Promo Killing Blow card for the big winner at each Store Championship.

SUPPLEMENTAL PRIZE PACKS

You may at their own discretion subsidize additional prizing from existing store product or provide cash prizes from collected entry fees. If you have leftover promotional cards from previous events, you may use those as bonus event prizing.

PLATFORM REGISTRATION:

1. Register for our proprietary Competitive Play Platform if you haven't done so yet: <https://play.echoesofastra.com>
2. Create a new Store account using social logins (Google). Do this as soon as possible, since store applications require Publisher approval.
3. Once approved, you may create events and register players. Each player must also make a player account at <https://play.echoesofastra.com> to be registered to an event.

CREATE AN EVENT

The AstraPlay platform supports various types of competitive formats. We recommend standard Constructed for weekly competitions, but you may also choose to host Limited formats (Draft or Sealed) if your players prefer.

1. Create an Event
2. Select Format (Swiss BO3 recommended)
3. Input Time/Location
4. Upload Images and Description
Publish the event and share the link with your community!

Share the event details with your players, and as they sign up, register their SkirmishID

RUNNING THE EVENT

On the day of the event, make final adjustments to your participant list to account for dropouts. Use the following guidelines to ensure things run smoothly:

1. Have one Judge/TO familiar with the Comprehensive Ruleset available for rulings.
2. Players must be onsite to qualify for prizing and scoring
3. Swiss Matches are Best of 3 and must be completed (no early cuts)
4. Prizes distributed at the end of the event
5. Record all match records in the online Play platform
